Bringing Government Back to the People A Contract of Action

1. There will be a new cooperative effort between entities to cut costs of government and increase its efficiencies.
2. There will be created a readable budget.
3. We intend to manage your money responsibly; it won't be wasted on unnecessary actions.
4. Every effort will be promoted to regain the trust of the residents with the council and mayor.
5. City ordinances will be enforced fairly and consistently; there will be no selective enforcement.
6. A long range plan for successful city administration will be established.



We, the Action Team Slate for the Lakeside City Council, pledge to propose the long term agenda when elected to the council:

1. **TRANSPARENCY**
 - A. All meetings, actions, and forms open and available to public without charge on a web site;
 - B. Residential voting for changes in fee structure or major changes in operation;
 - C. Revamping of city hall and administrative positions to more fully represent city needs;
 - D. Publishing council agenda well in advance of meetings and encouraging public input at all times.
2. **FAIRNESS IN GOVERNMENT OPERATION**
 - A. All residents' dealings with city government will be fair and consistent;
 - B. No cronyism or favoritism;
 - C. All ordinances enforced and enforced fairly;
 - D. Establishing an open and non-adversarial relationship between city government and residents.
3. **OVERSIGHT OF ALL GOVERNMENT ACTIVITIES**
 - A. Fair and frugal employee relations. Compensation to be on a set schedule and followed;
 - B. Fixing responsibility for government actions; review city charter and change where necessary;
 - C. Particular attention to sewer administration, efficiency, and costs of operation;
 - D. Establishment of a citizen advisory committee to the council to make recommendations to serve the city.
4. **ECONOMY IN GOVERNMENT**
 - A. Careful budgeting of expenditures with a readable budget showing costs and benefits; line item required;
 - B. No wasteful spending on nonessentials; reduce costs and fees where possible;
 - C. All major work for the city to be placed on bids.
5. **SECURING INCOME OUTSIDE OF INCREASING TAXES**
 - A. Securing grants;
 - B. Selling of surplus and non-useable assets and equipment;
 - C. Fund raisers;
 - D. Creating an attractive environment to attract new businesses, enhancing economy of the city.
