RE: STEP/STEG INSPECTIONS

Greetings Lakeside Residents:

It's time once again for the annual inspections of STEP/STEG septic systems connected to the City of Lakeside sewer system. If you are reading this your system is scheduled for inspection. These inspections are mandated annually to comply with DEQ regulations. RotoRooter of Coos Bay has been contracted to provide these inspections, make needed spot repairs and/or service the systems, and to report major problems to both the property owner and the City of Lakeside.

These inspections are intended to keep the operation of the City of Lakeside's Waste Water Treatment Plant in compliance with DEQ guidelines. As few as one or two malfunctioning systems can adversely affect the biological and chemical balance of the treatment system as a whole. Annual inspection keeps the screens and floats working properly and also identifies those systems that may need pumping, which is typically required every five years based on the level of solids in your septic tank.

Inspections will be starting on or about July 20th and will spread out over the next two to three months. You should get a phone call from RotoRooter's inspection team (provided the City of Lakeside has your correct phone number) with at least one day notice of when they we will be in your area. All septic tank lids will need to be free of obstruction (piled lumber, brush, equipment, etc.) and any alarm systems accessible for inspection as well. Needed pumping will be done by RotoRooter. If you have had your system pumped recently, it will still be necessary to inspect it as a part of this process.
