First order of business:

Treasury Report read by Sandy Thayer. Motion to accept minutes as read, made and 2<sup>nd</sup> motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

We have 39 calendars left – sold 136

We have set up an account for gas with Wagon Wheel in Hauser; they give us cost plus a small percentage – which is saving us quite a bit in gas. Opened the account with \$100.00, Sandy wrote them a check for that amount from our checking account.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Introduction of members.

Bill Usrey gave us the direct line to Dispatch: 756-8212

LCA has disbanded and will no longer be our sponsor. Sandy spoke with Madeleine (sp?) from the Lion's Club and they are willing to "sponsor" the Lakeside Citizen's Patrol. They were the original sponsors when this was first formed.

Bill Berman made a motion to accept the Lion's as our sponsor, 2<sup>nd</sup>, carried.

With the disbanding of the LCA we need to vote on board members – Chairperson, Patrol Leader, Assistant Patrol Leader, Secretary, Treasurer and Council member & Alternate Council Member.

Motion to open nomination for Chairperson made by Bill Usrey, 2<sup>nd</sup> and approved.

Nominated Sandy Thayer – accepted nomination

Nominated Bill Usrey – he declined nomination

Motion to have Sandy Thayer as Chairperson made by Bill Usrey, 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

Sandy nominated Bill Usrey as Patrol Leader, motion made by Bill Berman, 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

Richard Bridges volunteered to be Assistant Patrol Leader, motion made and 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

Sandy suggested that the Secretary and Treasurer position be combined all motion made, 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

Sandy Thayer nominated Suzie Marcy for Secretary/Treasurer, Bill Usrey 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

June Albee was nominated for Additional Council Member, motion made, 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

Laila Bridges was nominated for Alternate Council Member, motion made, 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried.

Discussion regarding jackets (which need to be worn at fundraisers and while on patrol), Sandy is going to check the list to make sure all of those that have retired from Patrol (or moved on) have turned in their jackets. There is a \$10.00 deposit on the jackets and when you leave the patrol you need to turn your jacket in as the cost of replacement is going to be higher than when they originally ordered them.

Sandy wanted to let everyone now that the Reiter's are moving and will no longer be members of the Citizen Patrol. That takes us down 3 members.

Discussion regarding the possibility of a new patrol car. Sandy said that she has spoken with the Sheriff's office and at this time there isn't any available to be donated to us. We need to look into replacing the front seat in the patrol car. Richard Bridges is going to call around to see if we can find a front seat and to get prices.

We have a substation in Hauser and that will make response time better.

We need to get prices for insurance at "commercial rate". Sandy asked that we all contact our insurance carriers to see if we can come up with a less costly plan. We will report on that next meeting.

Richard brought up fundraisers.

Grace shared a tip regarding identifying "crack houses", if you see tennis shoes (running shoes, etc) hanging from electric wires in front of the house that means they are open for business and we need to call it in.

Laila Bridges, Suzie Marcy and Bill Berman need to go out on at least 3 rides with 2 members to learn about calls & procedures.
