PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Lakeside wants to welcome visitors vacationing to our lovely destination.

Although it is still illegal to live in an RV as per certain sections of Ordinance 168, the Mayor and City Council realize we need to make provisions for those whose friends and family come to vacation or visit in our city.

With the help of our attorney, the City is in the process of writing a provision to accommodate your visitors until a revision of Ordinance 168 may be obtained.

Ordinances are laws and when you change a land use law, hearings must be held as well as informing State and local agencies. This can be a lengthy process and requires someone with law expertise. The Planning Commission has already recognized the need to update Ordinance 168 last amended May 1994 and the section regarding RV's in a General Residential zone last amended April 2007. The Planning Commission began by contacting The Department of Land Conservation and Development a couple of months ago, requesting a technical assistance grant. Unfortunately they were out of grant dollars for 2009-2010 year, so we will apply as soon as their grant for 2010-2011 becomes available.

We wish to make our city more recreational friendly for your visitors and until we can work out an equitable solution to this problem, the City is going to temporarily suspend from the date of this notice, any future enforcement of RV's not currently zoned for that use to allow your summer visitors.

We welcome written comments on this topic from the community to help us better understand your needs.
