In light of your call to me, this office will be reviewing the recent Ordinances and act of recurring nuisances and code enforcement. I understand there are a number of comments and concerns registered by citizens and others and we are certainly taking them seriously. In the meantime, I think everyone can rest assured that there has been no enforcement activity done under any of the new ordinances other than proceeding with letters, contacting individuals whose property has been complained about as being in violation of a provision of the nuisance ordinance. No one on behalf of the City is entering or plans to enter any property, and if that were to be done, it would only be done with court approval, and it would be a very extraordinary situation. To date, to my knowledge, the City has not acted on nuisance complaints by entering onto anyone's property, nor do they plan to. Since these ordinances have been called into question, again, we are reviewing that and we will be back to you very soon.
